**Vendors:** Vendors are welcome and must pre-register. Space is \$10 per vendor. Vendor must supply their own table.

Boon Companions is excited to hold this show even while we are cognizant of the health concerns that COVID-19 presents. We request that everyone follow CDC guidelines (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/animals/events-animal-activities.html>) of frequent handwashing/hand sanitizing and social distancing as is possible, as well as following state and local requirements. **We HIGHLY encourage and JUDGES MAY INSTRUCT that face masks/shields be worn while in the ring as it is not always completely possible for everyone to remain six feet apart.** Please pay attention to signs and directions of the show committee in ways to maintain distancing. These precautions are a small way in which you can show respect and care for your fellow exhibitors.

### SHOW RULES

1. **Bucks** are sanctioned by **ADGA** for the following breeds: Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Saanen, Sable, Toggenburg and AOP., ADGA rules shall govern. The order of the show is subject to change if needed to make the show run more smoothly/quickly.
2. **Nigerians** are sanctioned by **AGS in Rings 2-5.** The AGS Report of Awards (ROA) will be the basis for awarding of any AGS legs for the show.
3. Open show entry fee \$30 per animal if shown in all 6 rings; \$6 per animal per ring if not shown in all rings. \$7 per pen for the weekend (this includes tack pens or **any pens you use**). Payment can be made by PayPal to [macivj@windstream.net](mailto:macivj@windstream.net). PayPal fees must be paid by the exhibitor. In case of emergency, with 48 hours' notice given, fees will be returned, if already paid. Your early entry will greatly help Boon Companions to predict numbers and do all we can to be sure that each breed is official.
4. Penning will be assigned. Please be aware that all pens have vertical bars so plan accordingly.
5. Entries can be mailed, emailed, or entered online. **Mail entries to: Robin K. 6. The base date for the show is September 4, 2021.

7. Animals may arrive any time after 1:00 pm Friday, September 3, 2021. Please try to arrive before 10 pm on Friday, September 3 if checking in Friday night. If checking in on Saturday or Sunday morning, arrivals must be **completely finished checking in by 7:00 AM** on the day that you intend to show so that the show committee can conduct final preparations for the show to begin.
7. Prior to the show, the Show Secretary must be shown the original registration or recordation certificate, an ADGA/AGS stamped duplicate application or a faxed copy of application or original if stamped by the ADGA/AGS office. No electronic stamped duplicates will be viewed/allowed; hard copies must be present.
8. Check in must be completed **1 hour before the start of the day's first show**, fees paid by that time. **To check in, entries must be listed on an official entry form either already sent to the show secretary OR you may bring the form with you OR fill out the form there. Copies will be available in the office.**
9. The show committee asks that no animals showing evidence of sickness, disease or contagious lesion be brought to the show. This includes but is not limited to ringworm, sore mouth and abscesses. If the show committee sees an animal that causes concern, you may be asked to trailer the animal for the remainder of the show. (The laws of Missouri require a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for all animal exhibitions).
10. All exhibitors must be neatly and properly dressed. Show whites are suggested but not required except in showmanship.
11. All animals must be properly collared and restrained.
12. All animals must be disbudded, dehorned or polled.
13. If you want to have bedding or hay delivered, you **MUST** make your arrangements with Derek Eddy **no later than August 31**. 660-631-3189 or [derekskinders@gmail.com](mailto:derekskinders@gmail.com) .
14. The Missouri State Fairgrounds are located on the southwest side of Sedalia. The swine pavilion is a large brick building located northwest of the sheep barn. Showers will be available.
15. **NO DOGS IN THE BARN.** Service animals allowed while they are working (as indicated by wearing a service vest) only.
16. **No scooters, bicycles, roller skates/blades, etc. in the barn.**
17. **Camping:** RV hook-ups will also be available and will be handled by state fair personnel - <http://mostatefairgrounds.com/camping/> . There are no camper hookups at the barn, all camping must be in the assigned campgrounds. **Tents, including tent cots, are considered to be camping, thus no tents are allowed in the barn. Regular cots will be allowed in the pens but cannot be placed in the aisles. Please reserve enough pens to allow for your sleeping needs.** These rules are part of our agreement to be allowed to use the state fairgrounds.
18. **No parking on the east side of the barn. Please unload your bucks and then move your trailers out of the loading area as soon as possible to allow other exhibitors to unload.**
19. **Boon Companions highly encourages finished animals to show in the Champion Challenge class.** It may happen that an animal will be assumed to have earned a 3rd leg in a prior ring of the show. It is the exhibitor's decision whether to continue showing the animal as there is no way to get papers revised during the show to enable them to show in the Champion Challenge class. Continuing to show does not violate ADGA rules and the exhibitor did pay the entry fee to exhibit their animal. This is a paying show and it may be that the owner would like the opportunity to win the BBIS prize. Exhibitors should continue to model good showmanship regardless of their opinion on showing a potentially finished animal.
20. If someone is observed using excess force with their own or another's animal, they can be asked to leave the show. Boon Companions reserves the right to determine what excessive force entails.
21. Boon Companions Show Committee has the right to change or add to the show rules as needed.

**Showmanship-** Showmanship will be held on Saturday morning at 8:00 AM.

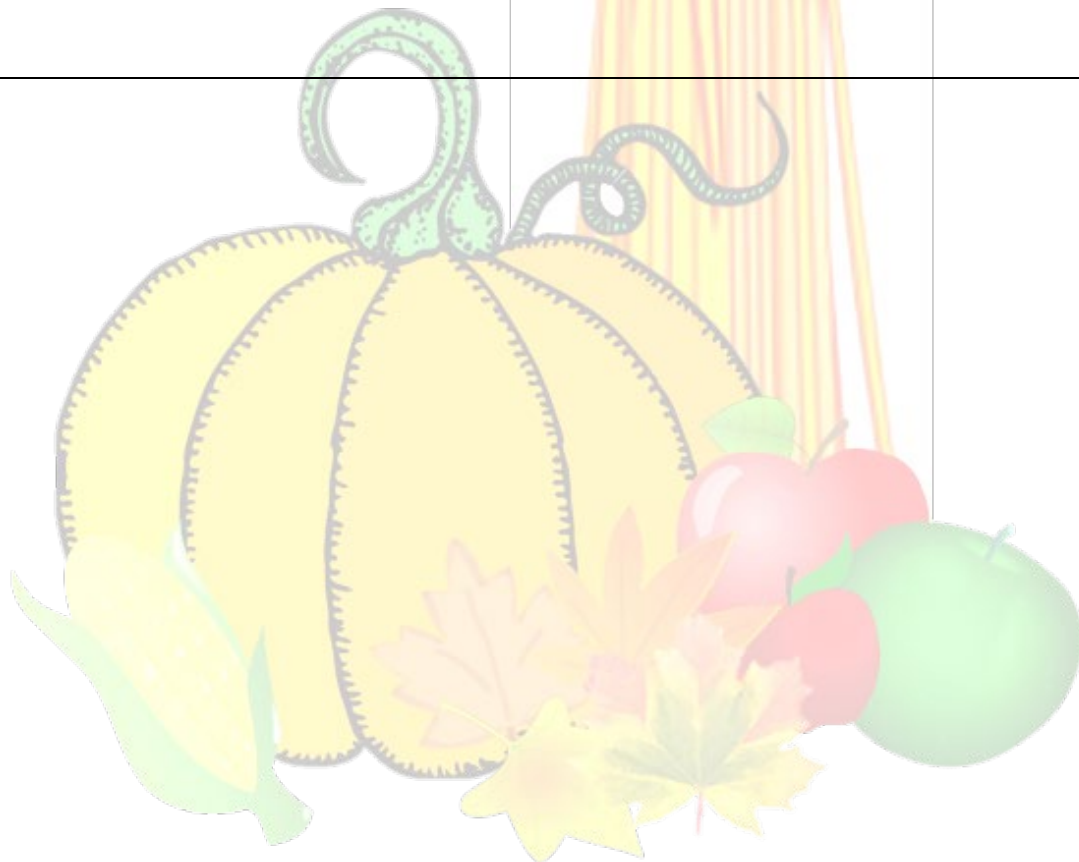

# Autumn Romance Select Goat Equipment Sale

New this year to the Autumn romance Buck Show will be a Select Goat Equipment Consignment Sale and not our usual Select Sale of dairy goats. We will, however, return to our Select Sale in 2022, making it our next Show Me Sale. The equipment sale will run as the dairy goat sale has with 60% of the sale going to the seller and 40% going to the Boon Companions. Everything consigned has to be new or like new . Let's say that you have some clippers that you have tried but don't like them. Clean them up, and we will accept them. But if they are old as the hills, never been serviced, no, thank you. We don't mind if things are refurbished, but they need to be clean, re-painted, if needed, and serviced/fixd to be accepted. We are also accepting semen into the sell. If you have semen that you want to consign, it must be on site at the sale. If you should be the winning bidder, you must be there or have made arrangements with consigner prior to the sale. Boon Companies will not be responsible for any arrangements of sale items once purchased, so please talk to the consignor in advance. A sale contract will be signed between the consignor and Boon Companions when an item is accepted for sale. While we will take these precautions to provide equipment in working order to buyers, sales are as is.
