Vendors: Vendors are welcome and must pre-register. Space is \$10 per vendor. Vendor must supply your own table.

Boon Companions is excited to hold this show even while we are cognizant of the health concerns that COVID-19 presents. We request that everyone follow CDC guidelines (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/animals/events-animal-activities.html>) of frequent handwashing/hand sanitizing and social distancing as is possible, as well as following state and local requirements. **We HIGHLY encourage and JUDGES MAY INSTRUCT that face masks/shields be worn while in the ring as it is not always completely possible for everyone to remain six feet apart.** Please pay attention to signs and directions of the show committee in ways to maintain distancing. These precautions are a small way in which you can show respect and care for your fellow exhibitors.

SHOW RULES

- Sr & Jr Does** are sanctioned by the **ADGA** for the following breeds: Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Sable, Toggenburg & Recorded Grades. ADGA rules shall govern. The Junior and Senior shows are separately sanctioned. The order of the show is subject to change. Specialty shows are not separately sanctioned.
- Entries must be postmarked, emailed, or entered online by May 24, 2021 so we can predict numbers and payment must be made by check-in if not sent with the entry. Payment can be made by PayPal to macivj@windstream.net. **PAYPAL FEES MUST BE PAID BY THE EXHIBITOR.** Open show entry fee \$5 per animal per show; \$7 per pen for the weekend (this includes tack pens or any pens you use). **Entries received after the above date will be \$7 per animal.** In case of emergency, with 48 hours’ notice given, fees will be returned, if already paid.

3. Penning will be assigned. Please be aware that all pens have vertical bars so plan accordingly. \$7/pen for the weekend..
4. **Send mailed entries to: Robin K. Nichols, 875 E Fox Hollow Rd, Ashland, MO 65010. Please make checks payable to Boon Companions Goat Club.** For more information contact Robin Nichols at prov2727@mail.com. The base date for the show is May 29, 2020 for Saturday and Sunday shows.
5. Animals may arrive any time after 3:00 pm Friday May 28, 2021. Please try to arrive before 10 PM on Friday, May 28, if checking in Friday night. If checking in on Saturday or Sunday morning, arrivals must be completely finished checking in by 7:00 AM on the day that you intend to show so that the show committee can conduct final preparations for the show to begin.
6. Prior to the show, the Show Secretary must be shown the original registration or recordation certificate for all ADGA/AGS animals 6 months of age or older. The original registration certificate or an ADGA/AGS stamped duplicate application or a faxed copy of application will be accepted for animals under 6 months of age (good for 30 days only). No electronic applications will be viewed/allowed; hard copies must be present. **NO RINGSIDE SUBSTITUTIONS! Animals must be entered in the show and the papers seen by the show secretary in order to enter the ring.**
7. Check in must be completed **1 hour before the start of the day's first show**, fees paid by that time. **To check in, entries must be listed on an official entry form either already sent to the show secretary OR you may bring the form with you OR fill out the form there. Copies will be available in the office.**
8. The show committee asks that no animals showing evidence of sickness, disease or contagious lesions be brought to the show. This includes but is not limited to ringworm, sore mouth and abscesses. If the show committee sees an animal that causes concern, you may be asked to trailer the animal for the remainder of the show. (The laws of Missouri require a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for all animal exhibitions).
9. No milk out is required but the judges will discriminate against distended udders.
10. All exhibitors must be neatly and properly dressed. Show whites are suggested but not required except in showmanship.
11. All animals must be properly collared and restrained.
12. All animals must be disbudded, dehorned or polled.
13. If you want to have bedding or hay delivered, you **MUST** make your arrangements with Derek Eddy no later than May 23. 660-631-3189 or derekskinders@gmail.com. **ALL ORDERS MUST BE PREPAID.**
14. **NO DOGS IN THE BARN.** Service Dogs must be approved prior to arrival, wear a service vest, and owner must have current, valid certification present and fully accept responsibility for all actions of owner & service animal.
15. The Missouri State Fairgrounds are located on the southwest side of Sedalia. The swine pavilion is a large brick building located northwest of the sheep barn. Showers will be available.
16. **Camping:** RV hook-ups will also be available and will be handled by state fair personnel (last year's rate \$20/day). There are no camper hookups at the barn, all camping must be in the assigned campgrounds. **Tents, including tent cots, are considered to be camping, thus no tents are allowed in the barn. Regular cots will be allowed in the pens but cannot be placed in the aisles. Please reserve enough pens to allow for your sleeping needs.** These rules are part of our agreement to be allowed to use the state fairgrounds.
17. **No parking on the east side of the barn. Please unload your does and then move your trailers out of the loading area as soon as possible to allow other exhibitors to unload.**
18. **Boon Companions highly encourages finished animals to show in the Champion Challenge class.** It may happen that an animal will be assumed to have earned a 3rd leg in a prior ring of the show. It is the exhibitor's decision whether to continue showing the animal or not at all as there is no way to get papers revised during the show to enable them to show in the Champion Challenge class. A junior doe could also have previously earned a leg. Continuing to show does not violate ADGA rules and the exhibitor did pay the entry fee to exhibit their doe. This is a paying show and it may be that the owner would like the opportunity to win the BDIS prize. Exhibitors should continue to be courteous if an exhibitor chooses to continue to show their animal.
19. If someone is observed using excess force with their own or another's animal, they can be asked to leave the show. Boon Companions reserves the right to determine what excessive force entails.
20. Boon Companions Show Committee has the right to change or add to the show rules as needed.

Senior does Ring 2 - Sable, Alpine, **Alpine Senior Get, Alpine Senior Produce of Dam and Alpine Dairy Herd Specialty only**, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Saanen, All Other Purebred, Toggenburg, Recorded Grade.

Junior does Ring 1 – Sable, **Sable Junior Get of Sire**, Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Saanen, All Other Purebred, Toggenburg, Recorded Grade.

Junior does Ring 2 – Sable, Alpine, **Alpine Junior Get of Sire**, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Saanen, All Other Purebred, Toggenburg, Recorded Grade.
